Sir

We beg leave in conformity with the Act of Parliament for regulating Provincial Theatres, to give you notice, that we intend at the next General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be holden for the Borough of Warwick in the County of Warwick on Thursday the 4th of October next, to Petition his Majesty's Justices of the Peace for leave and licence to represent or cause to be represented within the Borough of Warwick in the County of Warwick such Tragedies, Comedies, Opera's and other entertainments of the Stage, as are licenced to be Acted at his Majesty's Theatres in London commencing in November next and to be performed some sixty nights with in the ensuing four months Agreeable to the Act of Parliament made for the regulation of Provincial Theatres Dated the 10th day of September 1804.

The Petition of Edward Ray and George Collins Gibbon Theatrical
Managers and Performers and Reutors of the Theatre in the Borough of Warwick
aforesaid For Leave and Licence to represent or cause to be represented within
the said Borough such Tragedies, Comedies, Operas and other Entertainments
of the stage as are licensed to be acted and performed at his Majesties Theatres
in London or Westminster commencing in the month of November now next
following
and to be performed some sixty nights within the ensuing four months agreeable
and in conformity to the Act of Parliament made for the Regulation of Provincial
Theatres WAS PRESENTED by their Solicitor to this
Court and read And it was ORDERED by
the Court that such leave and licence be given and granted to the Petitioners
accordingly and in such manor as in and by such petition is prayed pursuant to the
directions of the said Act of Parliament PROVIDED nevertheless upon this Condition
and it
was further Ordered by the Court that such Licence shall not be valid until
approved by a majority of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the Borough
aforesaid of some meeting to be holdon for that purpose as by the said
Act is dictated.
