### **QS39/29, Epiphany 1898 (The Queen v William Lacey & William Warner)**

Page 60

On an Indictment for that they on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 1897 at the City of Coventry did feloniously cut parts of two holly trees the property of Walter Turrall then growing in a certain Garden of the said Walter Turrall situate in the Parish of St. Michael in the said City with intent the same feloniously to steal thereby doing injury to the said Walter Turrall to an amount exceeding the sum of £1. to wit to the amount of £5 -  
2nd Count. Feloniously stealing same.

#### **R v Lacey & Warner cont<sup>d</sup>**

Pleas: Each of them Not Guilty

Verdict: Both Guilty

Sentence: Each of them to be imprisoned two calendar months in Her Majestys Prison and kept to hard labour.
