NB: If you have time before 2 pm, it is well worth visiting the Stratford Guildhall (right next door to the Schoolroom and FREE to enter). There is the most amazing 'doom' painting there.

Parking and Directions

See Map. If you are very lucky you may be able to park in the Church Street car park; a pay and display car park very near Shakespeare's Schoolroom that is open at weekends. Otherwise I find the easiest car park is the Bridgeway Car Park (CV37 6YX) which is about a 10 minute walk from the Schoolroom. Payment is on return; you need to remember your Registration Number. There are 10 accessible parking spaces on Chapel Lane (opposite the Royal Shakespeare Company's Swan Theatre). This is a 3-minute walk from Shakespeare's Schoolroom & Guildhall. The Stratford Methodist Church, where we are having tea, is no more than a 5 minute easy walk from Shakespeare's Schoolroom but it also has its own car park.

Facilities and Access

Shakespeare's Schoolroom: There is only one toilet at the Schoolroom so you may want to take advantage of facilities at the Bell Court shopping centre (close by; marked on the map) or the Swan Theatre (these are suggestions given by the Schoolroom staff).

Some of the tour takes place upstairs. There is a lift suitable for wheelchairs but NOT mobility scooters up to the first floor.

There are 10 accessible parking spaces on Chapel Lane (opposite the Royal Shakespeare Company's Swan Theatre). This is a 3-minute walk from Shakespeare's Schoolroom & Guildhall.

Stratford Methodist Church. There is accessibility for wheelchair users and we are on the ground floor. There are toilets available, one of which is accessible. There is a car park at the Church, which is a 3 minute walk from Shakespeare's Schoolroom.
