

Transcript of the bond CR2981/5/8/4 Bond of John Vale re fishing without permission.

Whereas [th]e above bound John Vale was lately convicted before John Dugdale Esq one of his Majestys Justices of [th]e Peace for [th]e County of Warwick above written, at [th]e Prosecution of [th]e above named William Dilke, of Fishing in [th]e Freefishing of the [th]e said Mr Dilke without his Licence or consent And whereas upon [th]e said John Vales submission to [th]e said Mr Dilke and his Acknowledgement of his said Offence, The said William Dilke hath been pleased to forbear any further Prosecution, upon his being become bound not to offend in [th]e like manner for [th]e future: Now [th]e Condition of of this Obligation is such, That if [th]e said John Vale his Heirs, Executors or Administrators or either of them do and shall well and truly Pay or cause to be paid to ye said William Dilke his Heirs or Assigns, [th]e full Sum of ten Pounds of good and lawful money of great Britain within ten Days next after that He [th]e said John Vale shall at anytime hereafter be found Fishing in [th]e Manors Lordships, or Royalties of [th]e said Mr Dilke within [th]e County of Warwick aforesaid or either of them, And Proof thereof made by [th]e Testimony of one or more Credible Witnesses. Then this Obligation to be Void and of no effect or else to remain in full force and Virtue.
